The ISI "English in Action" summer camp is a fun and exciting way for teenagers to learn English.

- Duration from 1 week to 7 weeks, from late June to mid August

English in Action

English in Action Projects also take students outside the classroom. We use a select group of friendly host families who are all very experienced in welcoming international students into their home. These families all live within the same area which means students of all nationalities can take public transport together and have company during their free time.





Host Family

Host family accommodation allows the student to experience at first hand, family life and culture. The student will be placed in a home that suits their individual needs and requirements.

- Selected and inspected by ISI Dublin staff and Garda (Police) vetted.
- Around a 40-minute commute to the city centre & school by bus.
- Shared room with a student of the same gender and age group.
- Half-board meals: breakfast, packed snack and dinner each day, with lunch included at weekends.
- Accommodation staff at the summer camp available to help students with any questions or concerns they may have.

A simple hot lunch is provided at the school restaurant Monday to Friday and the host family provides lunch on Saturday and Sunday. Evening snacks and refreshments are also provided at the two evening school events.
